Pioneer Cemetery

POLICY

The Kenwick Pioneer Cemetery was gazetted closed on 10 August 2001 (Government Gazette No. 162).

Therefore, no persons may now be formally interred at the Kenwick Pioneer Cemetery by burial or formal placement of ashes other than those already recorded on file.

Families who wish to informally scatter the ashes of loved ones within the bounds of the Kenwick Pioneer Cemetery may do so, however no temporary or permanent memorial may be installed or left within the Cemetery.

Unauthorised temporary or permanent memorials will be removed from the Kenwick Pioneer Cemetery and disposed of by the City. Any works to existing plots and memorials need approval by the City prior to commencement.
