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POLICY NO. LPP 2.9 FILLING OF LAND

**PURPOSE** To formalise the City's position, and approach to dealing with,

filling of land.

### **POLICY STATEMENT**

### 1. APPLICATION OF POLICY

This Policy applies to all instances involving the placement of fill on land within the City of Gosnells.

## 2. OBJECTIVES

- (a) To clarify the City's position on the placement of fill.
- (b) To deter landowners from placing fill on properties without Development Approval.

#### 3. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

- 3.1 Filling of land that is not directly related to, or associated with, a bona fide use of a property or that is of a scale exceeding what could reasonably be considered as for domestic purposes, will be deemed to be "storage" for the purposes of a land use definition pursuant to Town Planning Scheme No. 6 (TPS 6).
- 3.2 Storage is a land use under TPS 6 which is prohibited on land zoned Residential, Residential Development, General Rural, Special Rural and Kennels.
- 3.3 Council will generally not support the filling of land, which would substantially alter existing surface drainage patterns, unless the application is part of a co-ordinated proposal to manage surface water runoff in a comprehensive manner.
- 3.4 Council will generally not support the filling of any wetland of watercourse.
- 3.5 Council will generally not support filling of land where the fill material is not clean fill. Council may require documentation certifying that the fill material is clean.
- 3.6 Council may require dust mitigation measures, such as a Dust Management Plan, wetting agents or wind barrier fencing.
