

## POLICY CP 5.4.46 APPLICATIONS TO KEEP MORE THAN THE PERMITTED NUMBER OF DOGS

**PURPOSE** To establish the criteria against which applications to keep more than the permitted number of dogs will be considered.

## POLICY STATEMENT

Under the City's Dogs Local Law 2020, the maximum number of dogs that can be kept on a property is as follows:

Property area less than 2,000m <sup>2</sup>	2 dogs
Property area between 2,000m <sup>2</sup> and 10,000m <sup>2</sup>	3 dogs
Property area over 10,000m <sup>2</sup>	4 dogs

- 1. The following factors will be considered when determining applications to keep more than the permitted number of dogs prescribed in the Dogs Local Law 2020:
  - 1.1 Any history of complaints in relation to dogs on the property;
  - 1.2 Any history of complaints in relation to dogs registered to the applicant, including those made to other local governments or the RSPCA;
  - 1.3 The adequacy of fences to contain the dogs.
- 2. Applications to keep more than the permitted number of dogs will be determined by the Chief Executive Officer.
