## PURPOSE

## APPLICATIONS TO KEEP MORE THAN THE PERMITTED NUMBER OF DOGS

To establish the criteria against which applications to keep more than the permitted number of dogs will be considered.

## POLICY STATEMENT

Under the City's Dogs Local Law 2020, the maximum number of dogs that can be kept on a property is as follows:

| Property area less than $2,000 \mathrm{~m}^{2}$ | 2 dogs |
| :--- | :--- |
| Property area between $2,000 \mathrm{~m}^{2}$ and $10,000 \mathrm{~m}^{2}$ | 3 dogs |
| Property area over $10,000 \mathrm{~m}^{2}$ | 4 dogs |

1. The following factors will be considered when determining applications to keep more than the permitted number of dogs prescribed in the Dogs Local Law 2020:
1.1 Any history of complaints in relation to dogs on the property;
1.2 Any history of complaints in relation to dogs registered to the applicant, including those made to other local governments or the RSPCA;
1.3 The adequacy of fences to contain the dogs.
2. Applications to keep more than the permitted number of dogs will be determined by the Chief Executive Officer.
