Additional Conditions of Library use for Minors

These conditions should be read in conjunction with Conditions of library membership.

There is no minimum age for joining, but those under the age of 16 years require permission from their parent or guardian.

Minors may not borrow the following, nor may it be borrowed on their card by their parent/guardian:

- MA and MA+ material can only be borrowed by minors accompanied by their parent/guardian.
- R rated materials cannot be borrowed by anyone under 18 years old.

Financial charges on the records of minors are the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian. Minors who turn 16 years of age and have outstanding charges due to their parent's previous use of their card will need to arrange payment of any fees outstanding.

Children under 6 years old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times. Children between 6 and 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult, or older sibling (13 years and over).

Minors who are unruly may be dealt with under the Library Board (Registered Public Libraries) Regulations 1985, Section 29 (2) a librarian may cause to be excluded or removed from a library

- any disorderly person.
- any person guilty of offensive behaviour
- any person who is not using the library for the purpose for which it is intended.
