



**POLICY CP 3.2.7**

**WA COMMUNITY CITIZEN OF THE YEAR AWARDS  
SELECTION PANEL**

**PURPOSE:**

To establish the City's approach to determining recipients for the WA Community Citizen of the Year Awards.

**POLICY STATEMENT**

Council will establish a Selection Panel to consider nominations and make recommendations to Council in relation to WA Community Citizen of the Year Award recipients.

**1. SELECTION CRITERIA**

Nominations for the WA Community Citizen of the Year Awards will be assessed in accordance with the selection criteria prescribed by Auspire – Australia Day Council of Western Australia.

**2. NOMINATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY**

Nomination timeframes and eligibility criteria for the Awards are determined by Auspire – the Australia Day Council of Western Australia.

**3. DECISION MAKING**

All nominations will be assessed by the Selection Panel against the Auspire - Australia Day Council of Western Australia selection criteria. The Selection Panel will make recommendations on Award recipients to Council for determination.

The Selection Panel will meet as many times as required in November of each year.

**4. MEMBERSHIP AND QUORUM**

4.1 The Selection Panel shall be comprised of:

- (a) Five Councillors.
- (b) A Councillor as First Deputy Member and a Councillor as Second Deputy Member.

4.2 Three Councillors will be required to form a quorum.

**5. ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT**

The following employees will be available to attend meetings and provide support to the Selection Panel:

- (a) Director Community Engagement.
- (b) Manager Marketing and Community Events.
