It's an Australia Day Big Breakfast

Tuck into a hearty breakfast and enjoy plenty of free entertainment this Australia Day, **Thursday 26 January**, at Centennial Pioneer Park Amphitheatre.

The annual City of Gosnells Australia Day Big Breakfast celebration includes stage shows featuring Blinky Bill and Bizircus, loads of native animals, mini golf, panning for treasure, children's activities and roving entertainment.

The City will also pay respect to the traditional owners with a smoking ceremony.

The Community Citizen of the Year Awards will be presented at the event, recognising and celebrating the efforts of local residents and organisations that go above and beyond to improve and support the local community.

Australia Day Ambassador Janine Wood will speak about the establishment of her not for profit organisation, No Limits Perth, which supports people experiencing crisis.

Gosnells Rotary Club will provide a barbecue breakfast for attendees, costing \$11 for a large pack and \$7 for a small pack. Food trucks will also be available, and community members are welcome to pack a picnic to enjoy in the picturesque surrounds of Pioneer Park.
