Terms and Conditions

To be eligible for funding, the host must:

- Submit application form 10 business days prior to event date.
- Receive approval for funding prior to hosting event.
- Be a local resident of the City of Gosnells.
- Hold an event within the City of Gosnells and on public properties, eg. parks, verges.
- Invite neighbours on their street and/or adjacent neighbours not hold a private gathering.
- Invite a minimum of five households with at least 10 attendees.
- Use the funding as part of the delivery of the Street Meet and Greet event ie. food, party games, balloons, plates, cups etc.
- Use the funding toward food for the event (excluding takeaway/fast food) and beverages (excluding alcohol).
- Comply with T&C's for hire of sporting equipment if loaned.
- Comply with relevant regulations and requirements for hosting a public event noise restrictions, organise waste management if applicable etc. It is agreed that the host will do their due diligence with regard to hosting an event.
- Provide an Event Summary and feedback form summary of the event, including copies of receipts, invitations, promotion and photos. The documentation is required within 10 business days of completion of the event.

Additional information:

- 1. Funding is accessible to one application per event, per street
- 2. The City will rebate up to \$200 per event
- 3. Host will receive funding after receipts/proof of purchase have been received and approved by the Safe City Team.
- 4. City of Gosnells is not liable for any injury or damage that occurs during the event. Please have an emergency plan in place for your event.
- 5. Applicants must not have a current outstanding debt with the City of Gosnells.
- 6. The host gift is a \$50 gift card and is provided to the applicant in addition to the funding after the event . The gift card is a non-refundable amount and cannot be exchanged for cash. See T&C's on gift card for further details. The gift card is provided by Gosnells District Neighbourhood Watch and arrangements for collection will be made directly to the organisation.
