



GUIDELINES FOR STALLHOLDERS AND PERFORMERS.

FUSION FESTIVAL – GLOBAL VILLAGE 2023

10 - 11 November 2023 (5-9pm)
Mills Park – 86 Brixton Street, Beckenham

Global Village is an integral part of the Fusion Festival, dedicated to promoting multiculturalism within our local community. If you're an enthusiastic stallholder, activity provider, or performer eager to showcase your culture to a varied cross-section of the community, we eagerly await your application.

Likewise, community members, cultural groups, and organisations have the chance to present, exhibit, or facilitate opportunities for individuals to engage in your activities.

Examples of activities include, but are not limited to:

- Global arts and craft.
- Cultural children's art and craft activities.
- Handmade artisan produce.
- Cultural demonstrations (e.g. weaving, basket making, tea making display, ceremony).
- Traditional games.

Please note: We are not seeking expressions of interest from food vendors or local food produce businesses for Global Village.

In compliance with the State Environment Health Acts and Regulations, please be advised that food and drinks (e.g. tea ceremony, coffee and others) are not to be provided or sold to the patrons by a stallholder, activity provider or performer in the Global Village.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The City of Gosnells is committed to delivering a diverse array of distinctive experiences, while also facilitating avenues for a wide spectrum of groups to participate. Regrettably, we might only be able to approve one application per group. Priority consideration will be given to applications aligning with the following criteria:

- Community groups or non-for-profit organisations based or operating within the City of Gosnells.
- Community or cultural groups based outside of the City of Gosnells but providing services to the local residents.
- An application that demonstrates the ability to provide, perform or create cultural activities.

Places are strictly limited and there is no guarantee that applying will result in being accepted to participate.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Stallholders must present the cultural activities on both days (10 & 11 November 2023).
- One group representative must always remain at the stall 5-9pm.
- Stallholders cannot sell products or goods.



- No food or drinks to be sold or provided from stalls or performers to the public
- Stallholders (including activity providers) and performers will be courteous in their interaction with festival patrons and other participants.
- No skin piercings to be undertaken at Fusion Festival
- Limited vehicle access.
- Adhere to the setup and pack up timeline.
- Interactive stall and activities.
- The City of Gosnells Risk Management and any directions given by City of Gosnells event staff must be adhered to by all stallholder and performers.
- Stallholders and performers agree to provide feedback after the festival, to enable the City of Gosnells to plan future community events.

INSURANCE

- It is a requirement of the City of Gosnells that stallholders and performers hold their own Public and product Liability Insurance. This insurance must be to the value of at least \$10 million and a current Certificate of Currency must be submitted to the City of Gosnells.

PHOTOGRAPHY

- Stallholders and performers need to consent to photographs being taken during Fusion Festival by event staff and a contracted professional photographer, to be used to promote the event and for future events via Facebook, the City's website and/or other promotional materials.

TIMELINE

Selection process:

The application closing date.	12pm Wednesday, 20 September 2023.
Application assessment. All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome.	22 September 2023.

Selected Stallholders and performers:

Thursday, 9 November.

10am – 4pm.	Applicants are welcome to drop equipment off. Storage venue will be open.

Friday, 10 November

9am to 2pm	Vehicle access to oval and stall setup
2pm	All vehicles off oval.
2pm to 5pm	Final stall setups (no vehicle access).
5pm	Event starts
9pm	Event ends
9pm-9:15pm	Stall pack up and cover up

Saturday, 11 November

4:30pm	Stallholders can arrive to reset and setup their stalls
5pm	Event starts.
9pm	Event ends
9pm-10:30pm	Stall pack down and bump out (vehicles permitted in parking area, but not on oval)

PROVISIONS FOR STALLHOLDERS

- The City will financially support you to conduct your activities (conditions apply).
- A 3x3m or 4x4m covered space, 2x trestle table, 2x chairs.
- General waste and recycle skip bin and water will be provided on site for stallholders to use throughout the event.



- Power is not guaranteed for every stall holder
