- Nominees will be notified by phone or email to arrange an interview and photo for their profile.
- Nominees may choose not to participate.
- Nominees will be provided with a draft of their interview to approve before their profile is distributed.
- My City of Gosnells digital and/or printed copies remain the property of the City of Gosnells and may be distributed or re-distributed at any time.
- The City reserves the right to choose which nominations are approved for use in the project and these can be changed at any time, without explanation.
