

## **Home is where the Art is**

### **Conditions of Entry:**

Entries are open to City of Gosnell's residents and ratepayers or people that work or attend school within the City of Gosnells only.

Entries close 4pm Friday 5 June 2020.

All entries must showcase the City of Gosnells in a positive way.

Please do not submit physical artwork.

If the artwork is not created digitally, please take a photograph of the work in its entirety, taken from a height so as not to skew the image. Please ensure the image is a minimum of 1 megapixel using the 4:3 aspect ratio and submit the original image (not resized and do not select a smaller file size).

Entries can be submitted in the designer's preferred file format; however, submission of a jpeg image is encouraged.

Entries are made via the City of Gosnells website [www.gosnells.wa.gov.au](http://www.gosnells.wa.gov.au) by completing the online application form and uploading a digital image of your artwork.

Please include:

1. Your name
2. Contact phone number
3. Address
4. School (If applicable)
5. An explanation of your submission/art work (maximum of 250 words). This may include how it was created, which medium has been used, inspiration behind each element or a description of the composition, as well as the competition category.
6. Please also state which category suits your entry best:
  - a. Pre-Primary – Year 3
  - b. Year 4 – Year 6
  - c. Year 7 – Year 12
  - d. Community group/Non-professional (not digital)
  - e. Professional/Digital. All digitally created compositions must enter under the digital category
  - f. Social Media

Post your image to Instagram and Facebook using the #mycityofgosnells to be eligible for the 'Gosnells Social' category.

Please retain your digital file and/or original artwork as this may be used if your entry is selected as the competition winner. The winner will also be asked for additional information about their entry.

In the unlikely event that no submitted design meets the criteria, the City of Gosnells reserves the right not to award a prize.

Entries that do not meet the criteria shown above will be ineligible.

The overall winning entry will receive a \$300 art supplies voucher.

There are 6 category prizes with each winner receiving a \$100 art supplies voucher.

Entrants agree to allow the visual reproduction of their submitted artwork for publicity and promotional purposes by the City. The City will attribute the artist wherever practical.

The winners will be selected by the City of Gosnells. The decision regarding the awarding of prizes is final and no debate will be entered into.
